

Daneshill Family FUN RUN Event Program in aid of the Matt Hampson Foundation (in association with Sherfield Park Runners)

1. Event

The event is a fun run open to Children over the age of 3 on the day of the event. This will take place at the Wellington Country Park on an approx. 2700m course. The run is on made paths and will start/finish close to the main café and toilet building. Children under the age of 8 can only take part in the fun run if they are accompanied by a responsible adult, who must run/walk alongside them.

This is a fun run, so no timing facilities will be available.

There will be 3 separate start times (waves), so as not to cause congestion on the course or the Race Headquarters. Each wave will be limited to 150 entrants not including parents running with their ward (child under 8). Note, only one parent or guardian per ward.

For participants who are members of an affiliated running club to England Athletics the entry fee will be £5.

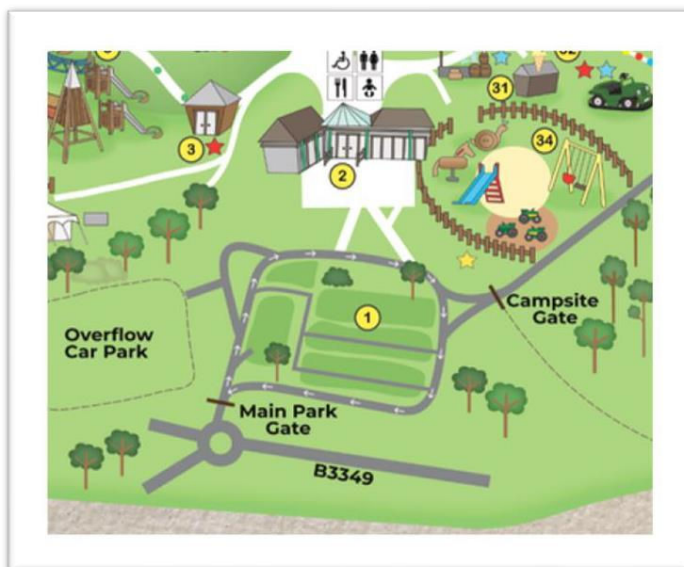
For under 8's, their accompanying adult does not need to pay, but may donate should they wish.
(Note: Adults running for free do not receive a race number, medal or goody bag).

6. Race Numbers

Race numbers will be available to collect on the morning of the event at the Registration Marquee, this will be open from 8:45am on the morning of the event at the race headquarters in the Reception / Café area, see map below.

7. Parking

Free parking will be available at the main car park at the Wellington Country Park, marshals present who will direct you to the appropriate area.



8. Facilities

Toilet facilities will be provided at the Reception / Café area.

Refreshments will also be available at the Café

PLEASE NOTE – THE COUNTRY PARK PLAY AREAS WILL NOT BE OPEN FOR USE BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE EVENT. This is a ‘no spectator’ event.

9. The Course

The course is approximately 2700m long on fully maintained manmade paths. All participants and visitors are required to remain on manmade paths so as not to damage any of the grassed areas.

The route will be fully signposted and marshalled on the day

Bikes, scooters, roller skates and pushchairs are strictly prohibited from the Event course on the day of the Event.

10. Animals

No animals are permitted at the event.
